### Chili Team Rules / Registration Deadline April 1, 2016

This is a fundraiser for the Aubrey Fire Department Auxiliary and Keep Aubrey Beautiful and should be treated as such an event. Please cooperate with all rules to ensure the success and safety of all.

- Each Chili team's entry should be no less than one full crock pot of chili. One 8 oz. Cup will be actually judged and the other portion should be available for samples to the general public which have been identified as wearing a colored wrist band. You may make more of the same entry for the same registration fee; however, every different recipe entry requires a separate registration fee.
- Each Chili team is responsible for the area assigned by the event coordinators. There will be no holding of spots until registration is received. There will be a limited number of spaces available, so submit your registration early.
- This is NOT a sanctioned chili cook off, and decisions of our volunteer community judges are final. All awards are in the form of trophies, non-cash value.
- Each team must bring their own cooking devices, utensils, table, chairs and a 10 x 10 canopy is required for your team site. Call if you don't have one, another team may have a spot.
- Each team must have a lid on the chili and must use sanitary serving utensils.
- Each team is responsible for keeping their site area clean and sanitary through out the event and must clean up team site afterwards.
- Each time is required to check in and set up NO LATER than 10 am and must stay onsite until 1:30 pm. Tear down is not to begin until 1 pm. Upon arrival and check-in, proceed to your designated area, unload and remove all vehicles. NO vehicles are allowed on the grounds or in area. (Check-in begins at 8 am, but not before).
- Each team will be required to sign a waiver of liability in which all teammates must sign, and adhere to all safety rules. Children must be supervised and not allowed to run freely around any of the cooking sites.
- Each team may choose to prepare their chili at home and bring it to the site, or they may prepare and actually cook onsite. Keep in mind, if the Burn Ban is in effect the day of the event, we will not be allowed to have any cooking with open flames. Plan accordingly.
- We strongly encourage decorations and space presentation as we will have a fun award for Best Decorations. You may serve crackers, corn bread, fritos, toppings, etc. with your chili.
- Concessions area will be selling hotdogs, soft drinks, iced tea and water. A bake sale will be selling homemade baked goods for taking home, these are other components to our fundraiser. **You may not sell anything at your cooking site.**
- No ice chest will be allowed except for carrying your fresh ingredients if you are cooking on site. Ice chests with drinks are allowed, but we strongly encourage you to support the event by purchasing drinks from the concession stand.
- EVERYONE needs to purchase the \$5 sample wrist bands if you are going to sample/eat ANY chili, including your own. This is a fundraiser and the success of the event is based on selling chili wristbands. Please make sure you, your team, and your family follow these rules. Even our volunteers are required to purchase a wrist band to sample the chili. (You will receive one band with chili entry.)
- Judging will be at 10:45 am and information when you arrive will be given explaining the exact judging procedures. A quick mandatory "Cooks Meeting" will take place at 10:30 am and all teams with all teammates are required to be in attendance.
- This is a rain or shine event with no refunds issued. Pre-event tickets are being sold and a rain plan will go into effect seven days prior to the event if necessary. We will keep you informed.
